## **For Surviving Spouse**

A surviving spouse may title a vehicle in his or her name only by submitting a title application in the surviving spouse's name. No fee is required if at the time of death, the deceased was a Maine resident, and the vehicle was registered and titled in Maine. A rush fee will still apply.

What you will need:	
☐ A Vehicle Title	
0	If you cannot locate the title to the vehicle, you will need to file a Duplicate
	Title Application (MVT-8) in the deceased's name.
0	The fee is waived for a Duplicate Title Application in this case.
☐ Application for Certificate of Title (MVT–2)	
0	An application for a Maine certificate of title can be obtained by visiting any
	of our motor vehicle branch or town office locations or by contacting the Title
	Unit in Augusta.
0	No title fee is required unless adding an additional owner.
0	If rush service is preferred, a \$10 rush fee will apply.
An MVT-22 completed by the surviving spouse.	
0	This document must be notarized.
0	If the vehicle was financed, the surviving spouse must submit a lien release

\*If a surviving spouse sells the vehicle, the surviving spouse should provide the buyer with:

or obtain consent from the lien holder to title in the surviving spouse's name

• The title transferred to the buyer.

- A release of any lien.
- Form MVT-22 completed by the surviving spouse. Must be notarized.
- Bill of sale.
