[¶1] Domtar Industries, Inc., appeals from a decision of a Workers' Compensation Board Administrative Law Judge (*Pelletier, ALJ*) dated July 8, 2015, and an order denying Domtar's Motion for Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. The only issues raised on appeal challenge the ALJ's decision that Domtar Industries is required to reimburse Mr. Doten for expenses related to the purchase of medical marijuana.

- [¶2] This appeal has been stayed pending the Law Court's decision in Bourgoin v. Twin Rivers Paper Company, LLC, 2018 ME 77, \_\_\_ A.3d \_\_\_ (decided June 14, 2018).
- [¶3] By agreement of the parties, and pursuant to *Bourgoin*, the board's July 8, 2015, decision is now vacated to the extent that it requires Domtar Industries to

reimburse Mr. Doten for the purchase of medical marijuana. In all other respects, the decision remains in effect.
